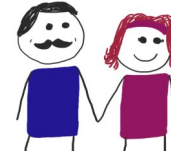

What our school does...



- Anybody who works at our school will be checked by the DBS to make sure that they are safe to work with children.
- Our school has a Designated Person for Safeguarding, Miss Smith who has had lots of training to identify what to do if she is concerned and she trains all of our teachers.
- Our school has an inventory system and locks on the external doors.
- Our school teaches us how to keep ourselves safe. Our lessons include, healthy eating, anti-bullying, e-safety, road safety, how to report abuse/concerns if we are worried about our safety.


What our parents do...



- Parents are the most important people to keep us safe they should
- Talk to school if they need help or support.
 - Let school know if their child has a medical condition or is off school sick.
 - Let school know of any court orders
 - Let school know if there is any change in circumstance such as house move, new contact details, change of name, change of parental responsibility.
 - Let school know who will be dropping off and picking up or of any additional changes to arrangements.

What should I do...



- Tell an adult I trust straight away
- Report anything that worries me 
- Keep all messages for evidence
- Don't keep worries to yourself
- Try to stay calm
- Try to ignore the person

What should I not do...



- Do not keep worries to myself
- Do not get angry or upset
- Do not delete messages, block it, don't open unknown links/attachments
- Do not be nasty or unkind back
